

Terms and conditions
SOCIETE GENERALE PRIZE DRAW AT SIBOS 2018

ARTICLE 1 : ORGANISATION

Société Générale, a public limited company with capital of 1 009 897 173, 75 EUROS (as of 1st Jan 2017), with the unique identification number 552 120 222 RCS Paris, and with its registered office at 29 Boulevard Haussmann – 75009 Paris – France, is organising a free contest with no services subscription obligation.

The contest will occur from 22 October to 26 October 2018 during Sibos conference in Sydney.

ARTICLE 2 : PARTICIPATION

The contest is free of any participation fee. It is exclusively reserved for the Sibos participants.

All those that participated directly or indirectly in the organisation or development of the contest cannot win the prize.

Société Générale reserves the right to check that the rules are being respected. Any participant who would not respect the present rules may be excluded from the contest.

Each person can only participate once.

Participation in the contest involves implies total acceptance of the present terms and conditions.

Entrants: Only open to applicants aged 18 or over. Employees of the Promoter, their agents, third parties, and any person professionally connected with this promotion and their immediate families shall be eliminated from the promotion at the prize awarding stage.

4.2 Notification

and regulations relating to access to Rugby World Cup venues and any other areas associated with Rugby World Cup (including any terms of accreditation determined by RWCL). Further each winner and his/her guest(s) acknowledge that he/she may be required to enter into a direct acknowledgement and/or agreement with RWCL and/or the Tournament Organiser concerning use of the tickets and compliance with ticket terms and conditions prior to receiving the prize.

4. **Third Parties:** The Promoter is not responsible for any third party acts or omissions.
5. **Responsibility for Promotion:** This promotion is run by the Promoter with the permission of RWCL. Accordingly the Promoter is responsible for the operation of and all matters and concerns relating to the promotion, not RWCL or any other persons involved in the staging of Rugby World Cup 2019 (including Tournament Organiser) and World Rugby (formerly the International Rugby Board), all of whom shall not be responsible for or liable to entrants in any way whatsoever in connection with this promotion.
6. **Cancellation of Promotion:** The Promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend this promotion due to events or circumstances arising beyond its control.
7. **Unlawful Entries:** Entrants must not be resident in a jurisdiction in which participation breaches any applicable laws. By entering, the entrant warrants that he or she is permitted by law in the relevant jurisdiction to do so.
